Family and Domestic Violence



1 in 3 Australian women will experience violence at the hands of a current or past partner at some point

1 in 5 Australian women have experienced sexual violence

Australian women are more at risk of assault in their own homes than in public

58% of women who have experiences physical and/or sexual violence in their home have **never contacted the police**

61% of women who experienced violence from an ex-partner had children in their care when the violence occurred

A Recent National Survey of Public Perceptions of FDV found.....

12% believe if a woman goes into a room alone with a man at a party it is her fault she is raped

22% say domestic violence can be excused if people get so angry they lose control

78% say it's hard to understand why women stay

51% say most women could leave a violent relationship if they really wanted to
